PROGRAM:

Throughout the two-week period our guests will take part in specially planned activities that empower sustainable connections; with each other, with nature, and in business. Guests will be given the opportunity to embrace nature's playground that is Western Jutland; from the southern tip of the "Limfjorden" to where the land meets the water on the shores of the North Sea.

While making new, lifetime friendships participants will:

- Get acquainted with Danish agriculture and local businesses that work within different aspects of sustainable development and the United Nations 17 goals;
- Visit a wind turbine
- Hike, sail and ride the waves in and around the Limfjord.
- Savor local flavors and delicacies from water and land;
- Sleep under the stars in "Klosterheden" plantation and much more.

As well as the planned activities participants will have time to adventure out on their own and delve into Danish culture and life or just hang out together.

Guests participating in the two-week summer camp will spend the first week getting to know one another and will stay together at a local hostel.

The second week guests will have the opportunity to immerse themselves into Danish living by staying two and two with individual host families. The guests will also enjoy a 2-day trip on the heath – "Klosterheden Plantation," where they will stay the night in a shelter and experience the special nature and wildlife.

INSURANCE:

All participants must have insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and third-party liability as per Rotary International guidelines.

INFORMATION:

All information regarding the camp will be sent to the participants directly. Acceptance into the camp will be sent immediately. Further details regarding the camp as well as an itinerary will be sent no later than May 31st. Along with the acceptance letter a bill for the camp fee will be sent to the participants. The registration will be final and binding once payment is received. Upon registration, accepted participants will be invited to a private Facebook group for additional information.
