OUR ARTISTIC DIRECTOR



Born in 1964 in Vila Real, Portugal, pianist, composer, arranger, and orchestra director **Carlos Azevedo** moves with equal ease in the universes of classical contemporary music and jazz, writing for the most varied formations from solo instruments to orchestra.

He graduated from the superior courses in **Piano and Composition** at the Conservatoire of Music in Porto and completed the Master's Degree in Composition at the University of Sheffield in the United Kingdom, where he earned his Doctorate.

Together with his teaching activity within composition, analysis, and orchestration, he has developed a career as a jazz musician, leading his trio, writing arrangements, and collaborating as a pianist in various projects.

Carlos Azevedo is an important protagonist of the Portuguese jazz movement. In 2001, he created the first Licentiate Degree course in Jazz in Portugal at the Superior School of Music, Arts, and Performance in Porto, and since 1999, he has shared the musical direction of the Matosinhos Jazz Orchestra with Pedro Guedes.

Endowed with excellent piano technique, he participates regularly in concerts and festivals. His suite "Lenda" for decatet was presented at the Jazz Festivals in Porto (1999), Nantes (2000), and Guimarães (2001), leading to the release of his first CD album under his own name.

THE CITY OF PORTO.



Porto is the **second largest city in Portugal**. In 2024, Porto was elected by the Erasmus Student Network as the **Erasmus Destination of the Year**, consolidating the Invincible City as the best place to go on a mobility program.

Porto is one of the oldest European centers, and its core was proclaimed a **World Heritage Site by UNESCO** in 1996 as the "Historic Centre of Porto, Luiz I Bridge, and Monastery of Serra do Pilar."

Its settlement dates back many centuries when it was an outpost of the Roman Empire. Port wine, one of Portugal's most famous exports, is named after Porto, as the metropolitan area was responsible for the packaging, transport, and export of fortified wine.

THE ARTISTIC RESIDENCY



Since 1985, ESMAE has continued the centuries-old tradition of teaching music in the city of Porto. Later, its training offer extended, thus becoming a performing arts school for Music, Theater, and Dance. It offers degrees in music, particularly in Jazz instruments.

It has 700 students under its care, 120 teachers of 70 different nationalities dedicated to making their creations an embrace of the city, the country, and the world in more than 200 annual artistic events.


THE CONCERT



Imagined to mark the festive year of 2001, when the city of Porto was European Capital of Culture, Casa da Música was the first building constructed in Portugal exclusively dedicated to music, both for its presentation and public enjoyment, as well as artistic training and creation.

The project was confirmed in 1999 as the result of an international architectural competition that selected the design by Rem Koolhaas and was inaugurated in the spring of 2005.

APPLICATIONS

Auditions Requirements

- Auditions are carried out by <u>sending a video</u> which should not be edited. The candidate must <u>record two themes</u>:
 - o The first recording consists of jazz standards at a medium tempo.
 - o The second is the recording of a Rhythm Changes in a fast tempo
- The application must be accompanied by a short biography.
- Full CV it must contain information about your faculty, academy or school of music, and the experience acquired as a jazz musician.

Please make sure to follow these rules:

- The subject should be: "Rotary World Jazz Orchestra YOUR NAME"
- Mention your name, email, nationality and if you are connected or were reffered by any Rotary Club or District.
- The videos, biography and CV files must be attached to the email. If the attachment size is too big, please send us the files with the help of a download link. You can use any file sharing platform you wish, but we recomend Google Drive or WeTransfer.

APPLICATIONS

Selection Procedure

 A professional international jury will select the best candidates. The candidates who make it through the first selection may be asked to present additional material.

Announcement of Results

- The jury will select up to 18 musicians to form the Rotary Jazz World
 Orchestra 2025, as well as a reserves shortlist who may join the project
 in the case of cancellations.
- All candidates will be notified about the results by the end of December.

CONDITIONS

A REGISTRATION FEE IS REQUIRED

- Individual participation has a <u>cost of €300</u> registration fee is nonrefundable.
- During your stay, all accommodation, main meals and material needs are provided by the Rotary Club Porto.
- Musicians must take care of their travel's, visas, and all other official requirements, as well as ensure they have sufficient pocket money for their private expenses.
- Musicians must have a good comprehension of English as all workshops will be in English. Portuguese is welcome too.
- Candidates are encouraged to approach Rotary clubs where they live to look for support for travel and registration fee.
- Selected musicians must insure their instrument(s), (except piano), travel, security and health.
